A BILL

To provide for the liquidation or reliquidation of certain drawback claims relating to petroleum products.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DRAWBACK CLAIMS RELATING TO PETROLEUM**
4 **PRODUCTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 514 of
6 the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other pro-
7 vision of law, the Bureau of Customs and Border Protec-
8 tion shall, not later than 90 days after the date of the
9 enactment of this Act, liquidate or reliquidate each draw-

1 back claim described in subsection (c) at the full amount
 2 in each such claim.

3 (b) PAYMENT OF AMOUNTS DUE.—Any amounts
 4 owed by the United States pursuant to liquidations or re-
 5 liquidations under subsection (a) shall be paid by the Bu-
 6 reau of Customs and Border Protection within 90 days
 7 after such liquidation or reliquidation.

8 (c) DRAWBACK CLAIMS.—The drawback claims re-
 9 ferred to in subsection (a) are the following:
