2 This Act may be cited as the “Health Education
3 Loan Payment (HELP) for Citizen Soldiers Act of 2005”.

5 **FESSIONS OFFICERS SERVING IN SELECTED**
6 **RESERVE WITH WARTIME CRITICAL MEDICAL**
7 **SKILLS.**
