5 Section 3(5) of the Occupational Safety and Health
6 Act of 1970 is amended by striking “but does not include”
7 and all that follows through “State” and inserting “in-
8 cluding the United States government, any government of

- 1 a State or political subdivision of a State, or any interstate
- 2 governmental agency.”
