## A BILL

To amend the Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946 to require country of origin labeling for macadamia nuts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COUNTRY OF ORIGIN LABELING REQUIRED**

4 **FOR MACADAMIA NUTS.**

5 (a) **GENERAL REQUIREMENT.**—Section  
6 281(2)(A)(vi) of the Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946  
7 (7 U.S.C. 1638(2)(A)(vi)) is amended by striking “pea-  
8 nuts” and inserting “peanuts and macadamia nuts”.

9 (b) **REQUIREMENTS FOR UNITED STATES COUNTRY**  
10 **OF ORIGIN.**—Section 282(a)(2)(E) of such Act (7 U.S.C.

1 1638a(a)(2)(E)) is amended by striking “commodity or  
2 peanuts” and inserting “commodity, peanuts, or maca-  
3 damia nuts”.
