A BILL

To provide for certain tunnel life safety and rehabilitation projects for Amtrak.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Northeast Corridor
- 5 Rail Tunnel Safety Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.
- 7 There are authorized to be appropriated to the Sec-
- 8 retary of Transportation \$898,000,000, to remain avail-
- 9 able until expended, for the use of Amtrak to complete

- 1 New York tunnel life safety projects and to rehabilitate
- 2 tunnels in Washington, DC and Baltimore, Maryland.
- 3 SEC. 3. AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.
- 4 The Secretary shall not make funds appropriated
- 5 under section 2 available to Amtrak for a project unless
- 6 the Secretary has received from Amtrak and has approved
- 7 an engineering and financial plan for that project.
- 8 SEC. 4. INSPECTOR GENERAL REVIEW.
- 9 The Inspector General of the Department of Trans-
- 10 portation shall conduct and transmit to the Congress an
- 11 annual review to determine whether the expenditure and
- 12 obligation of funds made available under this Act are con-
- 13 sistent with the purposes for which those funds are made
- 14 available.
