A BILL

To amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to require that foods containing spices, flavoring, or coloring derived from meat, poultry, or other animal products (including insects) bear labeling stating that fact and their names.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Food Ingredient Right
5 to Know Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7 The Congress finds as follows:

1 (1) Millions of Americans follow certain dietary
2 guidelines for health, religious, and cultural reasons.
3 These individuals depend on ingredient labels for the
4 information they need to abide by these guidelines.

5 (2) Under current regulations, food manufac-
6 turers are not required to identify the products used
7 in natural or artificial flavorings, colorings, or
8 spices, or some food additives.

9 (3) These additives often contain derivatives of
10 meat, poultry, and other animal products, such as
11 insects.

12 **SEC. 3. FOOD LABELING; REQUIREMENT OF STATEMENT**
13 **REGARDING SPICES, FLAVORING, AND**
14 **COLORING DERIVED FROM MEAT, OR POUL-**
15 **TRY.**

16 Section 403 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic
17 Act (21 U.S.C. 343) is amended—

18 (1) in paragraph (g), by inserting “, subject to
19 paragraph (y)” before the period at the end;

20 (2) in paragraph (i), by inserting “, subject to
21 paragraph (y)” before the first period; and

22 (3) by adding at the end the following para-
23 graph:

24 “(y) If it contains any spice, flavoring, or coloring
25 derived from meat, poultry, or any other animal product

1 (including insects) unless its labeling bears a statement
2 with appropriate prominence on the information panel
3 providing that fact and the name of the meat, poultry,
4 or other animal product, respectively.”.
