- 5 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.03.79 of the Har-
- 6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 7 thiophanate methyl and application adjuvants) is amended
- 8 by striking "12/31/2006" and inserting "12/31/2008".
- 9 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 10 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the $15\mathrm{th}$ day after
- 2 the date of enactment of this Act.
