Mr. THOMPSON of California introduced the following bill; which was referred
to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To adjust the boundary of Redwood National Park in the
State of California, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Redwood National
5 Park Boundary Adjustment Act of 2005”.

6 **SEC. 2. REDWOOD NATIONAL PARK BOUNDARY ADJUST-**
7 **MENT.**

8 Section 2(a) of the Act of October 2, 1968 (Public
9 Law 90–545; 82 Stat. 931) is amended—

1 (1) by striking the first sentence and inserting:

2 “The area to be included within the Redwood Na-
3 tional Park is that generally depicted on the map en-
4 titled ‘Redwood National Park, Revised Boundary’,
5 numbered 167/60502, and dated February, 2003.

6 The map shall be kept on file and made available for
7 public inspection in the appropriate offices of the
8 National Park Service, and shall be provided to the
9 appropriate officers of Del Norte and Humboldt
10 Counties, California.”; and

11 (2) in the second sentence, by striking “one
12 hundred and six thousand acres” and inserting
13 “133,000 acres”.

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
