6 merical limitation contained in section 214(g)(1)(B) of the
7 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
8 1184(g)(1)(B)) shall not apply to any nonimmigrant alien

1 issued a visa or otherwise provided status under section
2 101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(b) of such Act (8 U.S.C.
3 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(b)) who is employed (or has received
4 an offer of employment) as a boilermaker.
