A BILL

To delay for 2 years the general effective date of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Financial Safeguards
5 for Hurricane Survivors Act of 2005”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO BANKRUPTCY ABUSE PREVENTION**
2 **AND CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT OF 2005.**

3 Section 1501(a) of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention
4 and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (Public Law 109–
5 8) is amended by striking “180 days” and inserting “910
6 days”.

7 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

8 This Act and the amendment by this Act shall take
9 effect of September 1, 2005.
