1 SECTION 1. PROHIBIT STATE MINIMUM THRESHOLD.

2 Notwithstanding the individual assistance factors de-3 scribed in part 206.48(b) of title 44, Code of Federal Reg-4 ulations, the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency shall provide assistance and services de-5 6 scribed in section 408 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5174) 7 8 to individuals or households in Miami-Dade and Broward Counties, Florida, who suffered home destruction or se-9 10 vere damage from Hurricane Katrina in August of 2005.
