To extend the statute of limitations pursuant to state of emergency, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS PUR-
- 4 SUANT TO STATE OF EMERGENCY.
- 5 Chapter 213 of title 18, United States Code, is
- 6 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 7 "§ 3298. Extension of statute of limitations pursuant
- 8 to state of emergency
- 9 "In the case of a presidentially-declared major dis-
- 10 aster or emergency, in any district for which the emer-

- 1 gency authority was invoked, any limitation period pro-
- 2 vided by this chapter for the prosecution, trial, or punish-
- 3 ment of an offense, is tolled during the period in which
- 4 the courts are closed pursuant to the emergency, and for
- 5 one additional year from the date on which all operations
- 6 resume in the district courts within that district.".
