A BILL

To ensure that certain members of the United States Armed Forces are not subject to secondary airport security screening.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EXCEPTION FOR MILITARY.
- 4 Not later than 60 days after the date of enactment
- 5 of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security shall issue
- 6 regulations to ensure that no secondary airport security
- 7 screening is conducted of a member of the United States
- 8 Armed Forces who—
- 9 (1) is on active duty;

1	(2) is carrying orders that require the travel
2	such member is engaged in;
3	(3) is in uniform; and
4	(4) has valid military identification.
