## A BILL

To amend the Controlled Substances Act and title 18, United States Code, with respect to methamphetamine, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Increased Penalties
- 5 for Environmental Crimes Related to Methamphetamine
- 6 Act".

### 1 SEC. 2. CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT AMENDMENTS.

- 2 Section 401(b) of the Controlled Substances Act is
- 3 amended—
- 4 (1) in paragraph (5), by inserting "or manufac-
- 5 turing" after "cultivating"; and
- 6 (2) in paragraph (6), by striking "or impris-
- 7 oned not more than five years, or both" and insert-
- 8 ing "and imprisoned not less than 5 nor more than
- 9 15 years".

#### 10 SEC. 3. TITLE 18 AMENDMENT.

- 11 Section 1864(d)(3) of title 18, United States Code,
- 12 is amended by inserting "equipment and chemicals used
- 13 in the illegal manufacture of a controlled substance and
- 14 also includes" after "Such term includes".
