## A BILL

To amend the Controlled Substances Act and title 18, United States Code, with respect to methamphetamine, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Increased Penalties  
5       for Environmental Crimes Related to Methamphetamine  
6       Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT AMENDMENTS.**

2 Section 401(b) of the Controlled Substances Act is  
3 amended—

4 (1) in paragraph (5), by inserting “or manufac-  
5 turing” after “cultivating”; and

6 (2) in paragraph (6), by striking “or impris-  
7 oned not more than five years, or both” and insert-  
8 ing “and imprisoned not less than 5 nor more than  
9 15 years”.

10 **SEC. 3. TITLE 18 AMENDMENT.**

11 Section 1864(d)(3) of title 18, United States Code,  
12 is amended by inserting “equipment and chemicals used  
13 in the illegal manufacture of a controlled substance and  
14 also includes” after “Such term includes”.
