## A BILL

For the relief of Abraham Jaars, Delicia Jaars, and Grant  
Jaars.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL OF, OR**  
4                       **DENIAL OF ADMISSION TO, ABRAHAM JAARS,**  
5                       **DELICIA JAARS, AND GRANT JAARS.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections 212(a)  
7       and 237(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Abra-  
8       ham Jaars, Delicia Jaars, and Grant Jaars may not be  
9       removed from the United States, or denied admission to  
10      the United States, by reason of any act that is a ground  
11      for removal or denial of admission and is reflected in the

1 records of the Immigration and Naturalization Service of  
2 the Department of Justice, or the Visa Office of the De-  
3 partment of State, on the date of the enactment of this  
4 Act.

5 (b) RESCISSION OF OUTSTANDING ORDER OF RE-  
6 MOVAL.—The Attorney General shall rescind any out-  
7 standing order of removal or deportation, or any finding  
8 of deportability, that has been entered against Abraham  
9 Jaars, Delicia Jaars, or Grant Jaars by reason of any act  
10 described in subsection (a).
