 SECTION 1. WAIVER OF GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL OF, OR

 DENIAL OF ADMISSION TO, ABRAHAM JAARS,

 DELICIA JAARS, AND GRANT JAARS.

 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections 212(a)

 and 237(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Abraham Jaars, Delicia Jaars, and Grant Jaars may not be
- 10 the United States, by reason of any act that is a ground

removed from the United States, or denied admission to

11 for removal or denial of admission and is reflected in the

- 1 records of the Immigration and Naturalization Service of
- 2 the Department of Justice, or the Visa Office of the De-

- 5 (b) Rescission of Outstanding Order of Re-
- 6 MOVAL.—The Attorney General shall rescind any out-
- 7 standing order of removal or deportation, or any finding
- 8 of deportability, that has been entered against Abraham
- 9 Jaars, Delicia Jaars, or Grant Jaars by reason of any act
- 10 described in subsection (a).
