3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "American Evacuation

5 Planning Act".

7 Section 507(a)(2) of the Homeland Security Act (6

8 U.S.C. 317) is amended—

- (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (C), (D),
- 10 and (E) as (D), (E), and (F), respectively; and

(2) by inserting after subparagraph (B) the fol lowing:

"(C) of preparing communities and individ-3 4 uals, particularly individuals with special needs 5 (including low-income individuals and families, the homeless, the elderly, and individuals who 6 7 do not understand English), for evacuation from a major disaster by coordinating with 8 9 State and local governments in preparing or improving community evacuation plans and en-10 couraging individuals to establish a personal 11 12 plan to reduce the harm to individuals, businesses, and governments from such disaster; ". 13
