1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ADDITIONAL COUNTIES AND CITY IN APPA-**
4 **LACHIAN REGION.**

5 Section 14102(a)(1) of title 40, United States Code,
6 is amended—

7 (1) in the matter preceding subparagraph (A),
8 by inserting the following: “and cities located within
9 the boundaries of such area” before the closing pa-
10 renthesis; and

1 (2) in paragraph (L)—

2 (A) by inserting “Franklin” after “Floyd”;

3 (B) by inserting “Henry,” after “Gray-
4 son,”;

5 (C) by inserting “Patrick,” after “Mont-
6 gomery,”; and

7 (D) by inserting “and the city of
8 Martinsville” after “and Wythe”.
