2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF BOUNDARIES, SOUTH CARO-**
4 **LINA NATIONAL HERITAGE CORRIDOR.**

5 (a) INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL COUNTIES.—Section
6 604(b)(2) of the South Carolina National Heritage Cor-
7 ridor Act of 1996 (title VI of division II of Public Law

1 104–333; 16 U.S.C. 461 note) is amended by adding at
2 the end the following new subparagraphs:

3 “(O) Georgetown.

4 “(P) Berkeley.

5 “(Q) Saluda.”.

6 (b) REVISION OF HERITAGE PLAN.—The manage-
7 ment entity for the South Carolina National Heritage Cor-
8 ridor shall revise the heritage plan for the heritage cor-
9 ridor to reflect the expansion of the boundaries of the her-
10 itage corridor to include Georgetown, Berkeley, and
11 Saluda Counties, South Carolina. The revised heritage
12 plan shall be subject to review and approval by the Sec-
13 retary of the Interior as provided in section 606(c) of the
14 South Carolina National Heritage Corridor Act of 1996.
