## AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of Interior to convey to The Missouri River Basin Lewis and Clark Interpretive Trail and Visitor Center Foundation, Inc. certain Federal land associated with the Lewis and Clark National Historic Trail in Nebraska, to be used as an historical interpretive site along the trail.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, LEWIS AND CLARK NA-**  
4 **TIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL, NEBRASKA.**

5 (a) CONVEYANCE AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary of  
6 the Interior may convey, without consideration, to The  
7 Missouri River Basin Lewis and Clark Interpretive Trail  
8 and Visitor Center Foundation, Inc., a 501(c)(3) not-for-  
9 profit organization with operational headquarters at 100  
10 Valmont Drive, Nebraska City, Nebraska, 68410, all  
11 right, title and interest of the United States in and to the  
12 federally owned land under jurisdiction of the Secretary  
13 consisting of 2 parcels as generally depicted on the map  
14 titled “Lewis and Clark National Historic Trail”, num-  
15 bered 648/80,002, and dated March 2006.

16 (b) SURVEY; CONVEYANCE COST.—The exact acreage  
17 and legal description of the land to be conveyed under sec-  
18 tion (a) shall be determined by a survey satisfactory to  
19 the Secretary. The cost of the survey and all other costs  
20 incurred by the Secretary to convey the land shall be borne  
21 by the Missouri River Basin Lewis and Clark Interpretive  
22 Trail and Visitor Center Foundation, Inc.

23 (c) CONDITION OF CONVEYANCE, USE OF CONVEYED  
24 LAND.—The conveyance authorized under subsection (a)  
25 shall be subject to the condition that the Missouri River

1 Basin Lewis and Clark Interpretive Trail and Visitor Cen-  
2 ter Foundation, Inc. use the conveyed land as a historic  
3 site and interpretive center for the Lewis and Clark Na-  
4 tional Historic Trail.

5 (d) DISCONTINUANCE OF USE.—If Missouri River  
6 Basin Lewis and Clark Interpretive Trail and Visitor Cen-  
7 ter Foundation, Inc. determines to discontinue use of the  
8 land conveyed under subsection (a) as an historic site and  
9 interpretive center for the Lewis and Clark National His-  
10 toric Trail, the Missouri River Basin Lewis and Clark In-  
11 terpretive Trail and Visitor Center Foundation, Inc. shall  
12 convey lands back to the Secretary without consideration.

13 (e) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The  
14 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-  
15 tions in connection with the conveyance under subsection  
16 (a) or the conveyance, if any, under subsection (d) as the  
17 Secretary considers appropriate to protect the interests of  
18 the United States.

19 (f) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—To assist  
20 with the operation of the facility there is authorized to

21

1 be appropriated \$150,000 per year for a period not to ex-  
2 ceed 10 years.
