- 3 SECTION 1. COMPENSATION FOR JURY SERVICE TO BE EX-
- 4 CLUDED IN DETERMINING INCOME UNDER
- 5 THE SSI PROGRAM.
- 6 (a) Income Exclusion.—Section 1612(b) of the So-
- 7 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1382a(b)) is amended—

1	(1) by striking "and" at the end of paragraph
2	(22);
3	(2) by striking the period at the end of para-
4	graph (23) and inserting "; and"; and
5	(3) by adding at the end the following:
6	"(24) any amount received by such individual
7	(or such spouse) from any public agency as com-
8	pensation for jury service.".
9	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
10	subsection (a) shall take effect on the 1st day of the 1st
11	calendar month that begins after the date of the enact-
12	ment of this Act
