11	County, North Carolina.".
12	(b) Time for Submission.—Not later than three
13	years after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
14	retary of the Interior shall submit to Congress a report
15	containing the results of the study required by the amend-
16	ment made by subsection (b).
