3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.**

4 Section 20153(c) of title 49, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following new para-
6 graph:

7 “(3) The Secretary shall not require the sounding of
8 a locomotive horn in suburban areas in nonpeak traffic
9 hours.”.
