1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPLACEMENT OF CERTAIN COASTAL BAR-**
4 **RIER RESOURCES SYSTEM MAPS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The map subtitled “FL–64P”, re-
6 lating to the Coastal Barrier Resources System unit des-

1 ignated as Coastal Barrier Resources System Clam Pass
2 Unit FL–64P, that is included in the set of maps entitled
3 “Coastal Barrier Resources System” and referred to in
4 section 4(a) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16
5 U.S.C. 3503(a)), is hereby replaced by another map relat-
6 ing to that unit entitled “Coastal Barrier Resources Sys-
7 tem Clam Pass Unit, FL–64P” and dated July 21, 2005.

8 (b) AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary of the Interior
9 shall keep the map referred to in subsection (a) on file
10 and available for inspection in accordance with section
11 4(b) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C.
12 3503(b)).
