## AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to designate the President William Jefferson Clinton Birthplace Home in Hope, Arkansas, as a National Historic Site and unit of the National Park System, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. WILLIAM JEFFERSON CLINTON BIRTHPLACE**  
4               **HOME NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE.**

5       (a) ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY; ESTABLISHMENT OF  
6       HISTORIC SITE.—Should the Secretary of the Interior ac-  
7       quire, by donation only from the Clinton Birthplace Foun-  
8       dation, Inc., fee simple, unencumbered title to the William  
9       Jefferson Clinton Birthplace Home site located at 117  
10      South Hervey Street, Hope, Arkansas, 71801, and to any  
11      personal property related to that site, the Secretary shall  
12      designate the William Jefferson Clinton Birthplace Home  
13      site as a National Historic Site and unit of the National  
14      Park System, to be known as the “President William Jef-  
15      ferson Clinton Birthplace Home National Historic Site”.

16      (b) APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAWS.—The Sec-  
17      retary shall administer the President William Jefferson  
18      Clinton Birthplace Home National Historic Site in accord-  
19      ance with the laws generally applicable to national historic  
20      sites, including the Act entitled “An Act to establish a Na-  
21      tional Park Service, and for other purposes”, approved  
22      August 25, 1916 (16 U.S.C. 1–4), and the Act entitled  
23      “An Act to provide for the preservation of historic Amer-  
24      ican sites, buildings, objects and antiquities of national

1 significance, and for other purposes”, approved August  
2 21, 1935 (16 U.S.C. 461 et seq.).
