Mr. SIMPSON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To extend the operation of the President's National Hire
Veterans Committee, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Hire Veterans Act of
5 2004".

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF OPERATION OF THE PRESIDENT'S**
7 **NATIONAL HIRE VETERANS COMMITTEE.**

8 (a) **THREE-YEAR EXTENSION.**—Subsection (f) of
9 section 6 of the Jobs for Veterans Act (Public Law 107–

1 288; 116 Stat. 2048) is amended by striking “December
2 31, 2005” and inserting “December 31, 2008”.

3 (b) ADDITIONAL FUNDING.—Such section is further
4 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
5 section:

6 “(h) FUNDING FOR FISCAL YEARS 2006 THROUGH
7 2008.—From amounts made available to the Secretary of
8 Labor in each of fiscal years 2006, 2007, and 2008 for
9 the activities of disabled veterans’ outreach program spe-
10 cialists appointed under section 4103A of title 38, United
11 States Code, and local veterans’ employment representa-
12 tives assigned under section 4104 of such title, 0.5 percent
13 of such amounts in each such fiscal year shall be made
14 available to the Secretary to carry out this section.”.

15 (c) ADDITIONAL REPORTS.—Subsection (e) of such
16 section is amended by striking “and 2005,” and inserting
17 “2005, 2006, 2007, and 2008,”.
