A BILL

To ensure that local governments can function in the case of a declared emergency or major disaster.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Preservation of Local
- 5 Government Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. LOCAL RECOVERY.
- 7 Title IV of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and
- 8 Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5170a et seq.) is
- 9 amended by inserting after section 424 the following:

1 "SEC. 425. LOCAL RECOVERY.

2	"(a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other pro-
3	vision of Federal law, the President, acting through the
4	Director, may provide an eligible local government with
5	financial assistance to enable such government to pay all
6	or part of the expenses necessary to pay its local public
7	employees. The Director may provide such assistance for
8	a period of up to 6 months, or longer if the Director deter-
9	mines that such local government is unable to generate
10	enough revenue to pay such expenses.
11	"(b) Eligibility.—For a local government to be eli-
12	gible to receive assistance under this section, such govern-
13	ment shall—
14	"(1) be located in an area declared as an emer-
15	gency or major disaster; and
16	"(2) certify to the Director that it is unable to
17	generate enough revenue to pay expenses referred to
18	in subsection (a).".

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
