3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans' Access to
- 5 Local Health Care Options and Resources Act".

1SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR PAYMENTS TO FACILITIES2OTHER THAN THE DEPARTMENT OF VET-3ERANS AFFAIRS FOR COVERED HEALTH4SERVICES.

5 (a) REQUIREMENT TO AUTHORIZE RECEIPT OF COV6 ERED HEALTH SERVICES AT NON-DEPARTMENT FACILI7 TIES PURSUANT TO CONTRACTS WITH SUCH FACILI8 TIES.—Subsection (a) of section 1703 of title 38, United
9 States Code, is amended to read as follows:

10 "(a) An enrolled veteran may elect to receive covered 11 health services through a non-Department facility. Such an election shall be made by submission to the Secretary 12 13 of an application in accordance with such regulations as the Secretary prescribes. The Secretary shall authorize 14 such services to be furnished to such veteran pursuant to 15 contracting with such a facility to furnish such services 16 to such a veteran, as authorized in section 1710 of this 17 18 title.".

(b) DESCRIPTIONS OF COVERED HEALTH SERVICES
20 AND ENROLLED VETERANS.—Such section is further
21 amended by adding at the end the following new sub22 section:

23 "(e) For purposes of subsection (a)—

24 "(1) a covered health service is any hospital

scribed in such subsection is eligible under this title;
 and

3 "(2) an enrolled veteran is a veteran who is en4 rolled in the system of patient enrollment established
5 under section 1705(a) of this title.".

6 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

7 The Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall implement 8 the amendments made by section 2 in order for enrolled 9 veterans described in section 1703(e)(2) of title 38, United 10 States Code, as added by section 2(b), to receive covered 11 health services in accordance with section 1703(a) of such 12 title, as amended by section 2(a), starting on January 1, 13 2007.

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
