To designate the visitor center and other related facilities
at the U.S.S. Arizona Memorial in Hawaii as the “Pearl
Harbor Memorial Site”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF PEARL HARBOR MEMORIAL**
4 **SITE VISITOR CENTER AND OTHER RELATED**
5 **FACILITIES.**

6 (a) DESIGNATION.—The visitor center, museum,
7 bookstore, exhibits, and other related facilities located on
8 the shore at the U.S.S. Arizona Memorial in Hawaii, are
9 hereby designated as the “Pearl Harbor Memorial Site”.

1 (b) REFERENCE.—Any reference to the visitor center,
2 museum, bookstore, exhibits, and other related facilities
3 located on the shore at the U.S.S. Arizona Memorial in
4 Hawaii, in any law, regulation, map, document, record, or
5 other paper of the United States shall be considered to
6 be a reference to the “Pearl Harbor Memorial Site”.
