3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Disabled Veterans
- 5 Sports and Special Events Promotion Act of 2005".

1SEC. 2. DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS OFFICE OF2NATIONAL VETERANS SPORTS PROGRAMS3AND SPECIAL EVENTS.

4 (a) ESTABLISHMENT OF OFFICE OF NATIONAL VET5 ERANS SPORTS PROGRAMS AND SPECIAL EVENTS.—
6 Chapter 3 of title 38, United States Code, is amended by
7 adding at the end the following new section:

8 "§321. Office of National Veterans Sports Programs 9 and Special Events

10 "(a) There is in the Department an Office of Na11 tional Veterans Sports Programs and Special Events.
12 There is at the head of the Office a Director.

13 "(b) Subject to the direction of the Secretary, the Di-14 rector—

15 "(1) shall establish and carry out qualifying16 programs and events;

17 "(2) may provide for sponsorship by the De-18 partment of qualifying programs and events;

19 "(3) may provide for, facilitate, and encourage
20 participation by disabled veterans in qualifying pro21 grams and events; and

"(4) shall cooperate with the United States
Olympic Committee and its subsidiaries to promote
the participation of disabled veterans in sporting
events sponsored by the United States Olympic
Committee and its subsidiaries.

"(c) For purposes of this section, a qualifying program or event is a sports program or other event in which
veterans with disabilities participate and that is approved
by the Secretary as being consistent with the goals and
missions of the Department.".

6 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
7 at the beginning of such chapter is amended by adding
8 at the end the following new item:

"321. Office of National Veterans Sports Programs and Special Events.".
