## A BILL

To amend the Residential Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Act of 1992 to provide assistance for residential properties designated as Superfund sites.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. GRANTS FOR LEAD-BASED PAINT HAZARD RE-**  
4       **DUCTION IN TARGET HOUSING.**

5       Section 1011 of the Residential Lead-Based Paint  
6       Hazard Reduction Act of 1992 (42 U.S.C. 4852) is  
7       amended—

8               (1) by redesignating subsection (p) as sub-  
9       section (q); and

1           (2) by inserting after subsection (o) the fol-  
2       lowing:

3       “(p) PRIORITY FOR SUPERFUND SITES.—In award-  
4   ing grants under this section, the Secretary shall give pri-  
5   ority consideration to activities to be undertaken on resi-  
6   dential properties listed on the National Priorities List es-  
7   tablished under section 105 of the Comprehensive Envi-  
8   ronmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (42  
9   U.S.C. 9605).”.
