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## A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to require all gasoline sold for use in motor vehicles to contain 10 percent renewable fuel in the year 2010 and thereafter, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “10 by 10 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. 10 PERCENT RENEWABLE FUEL REQUIRED FOR**  
2 **MOTOR VEHICLES.**

3 Section 211 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7545)  
4 is amended by redesignating subsection (o) as (p) and by  
5 inserting the following new subsection after subsection (n):  
6 “(o) 10 PERCENT RENEWABLE FUEL REQUIRE-  
7 MENT.—After December 31, 2009, it shall be unlawful for  
8 any person to sell or offer for sale, supply, or offer for  
9 supply, dispense, transport, or introduce into commerce,  
10 for use in any motor vehicle (as defined in section 216(2))  
11 any gasoline containing less than 10 percent renewable  
12 fuel by volume. For purposes of enforcing the preceding  
13 sentence, a blend of gasoline and renewable fuel shall be  
14 considered to be in compliance with this subsection if the  
15 renewable fuel content, exclusive of denaturants and per-  
16 mitted contaminants, comprises not less than 9.2 percent  
17 by volume and not more than 10 percent by volume of  
18 the blend as determined by the Administrator. The Ad-  
19 ministrator shall, by rule effective January 1, 2010, re-  
20 quire that each bill of lading or shipping manifest for all  
21 gasoline containing renewable fuel and all gasoline not  
22 containing renewable fuel indicate the renewable fuel con-  
23 tent of the gasoline. The Administrator shall provide, by  
24 rule, for appropriate notices to be displayed on gasoline  
25 pumps indicating the renewable fuel content of the gaso-  
26 line and notifying the public of the prohibition contained

1 in this subsection. Such rules shall also provide an exemp-  
2 tion from the requirements of this subsection in the case  
3 of gasoline for use in collector motor vehicles, as defined  
4 by the Administrator.”.

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
