6	(a) General Verification.—Not later than one
7	year after the date of the enactment of this Act, and on
8	a biannual basis thereafter, the Commissioner of the Bu-
9	reau of Customs and Border Protection of the Department
10	of Homeland Security shall verify on-site the security
11	measures of each individual and entity that is partici-
12	pating in the Customs-Trade Partnership Against Ter-
13	rorism (C-TPAT) program and the Free And Secure
14	Trade (FAST) program.
15	(b) Policies for Noncompliance With C-TPAT
16	PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS.—The Commissioner shall es-
17	tablish policies for non-compliance with the requirements
18	of the C-TPAT program by individuals and entities par-
19	ticipating in the program, including probation or expulsion
20	from the program, as appropriate.
