3 **SECTION 1. NAME OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS**

4 **MEDICAL FACILITY, IRON MOUNTAIN, MICH-**
5 **IGAN.**

6 The Department of Veterans Affairs medical facility
7 in Iron Mountain, Michigan, shall after the date of the
8 enactment of this Act be known and designated as the

1 “Oscar G. Johnson Department of Veterans Affairs Med-
2 ical Facility”. Any reference to that medical facility in any
3 law, regulation, map, document, record, or other paper of
4 the United States shall be considered to be a reference
5 to the Oscar G. Johnson Department of Veterans Affairs
6 Medical Facility.
