#### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Returning Competence
- 5 and Credibility to American Disaster Management".

### 6 SEC. 2. FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY.

- 7 (a) DIRECTOR.—
- 8 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Federal Emergency
- 9 Management Agency shall be headed by a Director

1	who shall be appointed by the President, by and
2	with the consent of the Senate.
3	(2) TERM OF APPOINTMENT.—The term of a
4	Director appointed after the date of enactment of
5	this Act shall be for a period of five years.
6	(b) DEPUTY DIRECTOR.—
7	(1) IN GENERAL.—There shall be in the Fed-
8	eral Emergency Management Agency a Deputy Di-
9	rector who shall be appointed by the President, by
10	and with the consent of the Senate.
11	(2) DIRECTOR VACANCY.—In the case of a va-
12	cancy of the Director position, the Deputy Director
13	may not fill such position, except as a temporary
14	acting Director, unless the Deputy Director is ap-

17	(c) QUALIFICATIONS.—The Director and Deputy Di-
18	rector of the Federal Emergency Management Agency
19	shall be appointed from among persons who have extensive
