- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Abolishing Aviation
- 5 Barriers Act of 2005".
- 6 SEC. 2. RONALD REAGAN WASHINGTON NATIONAL AIR-
- 7 PORT.
- 8 (a) In General.—Chapter 449 of title 49, United
- 9 States Code, is amended by striking section 49109.

- 1 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The analysis for chap-
- 2 ter 449 of title 49, United States Code, is amended by
- 3 striking the item relating to section 49109 and inserting
- 4 the following:

"44901. Repealed.".

- 5 SEC. 3. TERMINATION OF FEDERAL SUPPORT FOR PERIM-
- 6 ETER RULE AT NEW YORK LAGUARDIA AIR-
- 7 PORT.
- 8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no Fed-
- 9 eral funds may be obligated or expended after the date
- 10 of enactment of this Act to enforce the Port Authority of
- 11 New York and New Jersey rule banning flights beyond
- 12 1,500 miles (or any other flight distance related restric-
- 13 tion) from arrival or departure at New York LaGuardia
- 14 Airport.
