## A BILL

To prohibit the Assistant Secretary of Homeland Security (Transportation Security Administration) from removing any item from the current list of items prohibited from being carried aboard a passenger aircraft.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Leave All Blades Be-  
5       hind Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. PROHIBITED ITEMS LIST.**

7       The Assistant Secretary of Homeland Security  
8       (Transportation Security Administration) shall not modify

1 the list of items prohibited from being carried aboard a  
2 passenger aircraft operated by an air carrier or foreign  
3 air carrier in air transportation or intrastate air transpor-  
4 tation set forth in section 1540 of title 49, Code of Federal  
5 Regulations, so as to permit any item contained on the  
6 list as of December 1, 2005, to be carried aboard a pas-  
7 senger aircraft.
