Mr. BAIRD introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

## A BILL

For the relief of Juanita Jimenez.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RELIEF FROM LIABILITY.**

4 (a) FOR CERTAIN DUPLICATE PAYMENTS.—Juanita  
5 Jimenez of Vancouver, Washington, is relieved of liability  
6 to the United States in the amount of \$5,631.85, rep-  
7 resenting the amount of duplicate payments certified by  
8 Juanita Jimenez, as certifying officer for the Gifford Pin-  
9 chot National Forest, in 2001.

10 (b) CREDIT TO ACCOUNTS OF THE UNITED  
11 STATES.—In the audit and settlement of the accounts of  
12 any certifying or disbursing officer of the United States,

1 credit shall be given for the amount for which liability is  
2 relieved by subsection (a).

3 **SEC. 2. PAYMENT BY THE SECRETARY OF THE TREASURY.**

4 (a) REFUND OF AMOUNTS PAID OR WITHHELD.—

5 The Secretary of the Treasury shall pay to Juanita Ji-  
6 menez, out of any amounts in the Treasury not otherwise  
7 appropriated, an amount equal to the aggregate of any  
8 amounts paid by her to, or withheld from any sums other-  
9 wise due her by, the United States with respect to the  
10 liability to the United States referred to in section 1.

11 (b) LIMITATION ON ATTORNEY AND AGENT FEES.—

12 Not more than an amount equal to 10 percent of the  
13 amount paid pursuant to subsection (a) may be paid to  
14 or received by any attorney or agent for services rendered  
15 to Juanita Jimenez with respect to the liability referred  
16 to in section 1. Any person who violates this subsection  
17 shall be subject to a fine under title 18, United States  
18 Code.
