- 7 (a) Termination of Program.—Subsection (a) of
- 8 section 108 of the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act of 2002
- 9 (15 U.S.C. 6701 note) is amended by striking "December
- 10 31, 2005" and inserting "March 31, 2006".

- 1 (b) Extension of Program Year 3.—Subpara-
- 2 graph (D) of section 102(11) of the Terrorism Risk Insur-
- 3 ance Act of 2002 (15 U.S.C. 6701 note) is amended by
- 4 striking "December 31, 2005" and inserting "March 31,
- 5 2006".
- 6 (c) Mandatory Availability.—Section 103(c) of
- 7 the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act of 2002 (15 U.S.C.
- 8 6701 note) is amended—
- 9 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking "Program
- 10 Year 2" and inserting "Program Year 3"; and
- 11 (2) by striking paragraph (2).
