## A BILL

To temporarily extend the applicability of Terrorism Risk  
Insurance Act of 2002.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Terrorism Risk Insur-  
5       ance Program Temporary Extension Act of 2005”.

6       **SEC. 2. TEMPORARY EXTENSION.**

7       (a) **TERMINATION OF PROGRAM.**—Subsection (a) of  
8       section 108 of the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act of 2002  
9       (15 U.S.C. 6701 note) is amended by striking “December  
10      31, 2005” and inserting “March 31, 2006”.

1       (b) EXTENSION OF PROGRAM YEAR 3.—Subpara-  
2 graph (D) of section 102(11) of the Terrorism Risk Insur-  
3 ance Act of 2002 (15 U.S.C. 6701 note) is amended by  
4 striking “December 31, 2005” and inserting “March 31,  
5 2006”.

6       (c) MANDATORY AVAILABILITY.—Section 103(c) of  
7 the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act of 2002 (15 U.S.C.  
8 6701 note) is amended—

9               (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “Program  
10 Year 2” and inserting “Program Year 3”; and

11              (2) by striking paragraph (2).
