1 **SECTION 1. REPAIR, RESTORATION, AND REPLACEMENT OF**
2 **DAMAGED PRIVATE NONPROFIT EDU-**
3 **CATIONAL FACILITIES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 406(a)(3)(B) of the Rob-
5 ert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance
6 Act (42 U.S.C. 5172) is amended by inserting “edu-
7 cation,” after “communications,”.

8 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-
9 section (a) shall apply with respect to a major disaster
10 declaration made on or after August 28, 2005.
