A BILL

To require rate integration for wireless interstate toll charges.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Insular Rate for Cel-
- 5 lular Customers Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. RATE INTEGRATION FOR WIRELESS COMMUNICA-
- 7 TIONS SERVICES.
- 8 Section 254(g) of the Communications Act of 1934
- 9 (47 U.S.C. 254(g)) is amended by adding at the end the
- 10 following: "For the purposes of the preceding sentence,

- 1 a provider of a commercial mobile radio service shall, with
- 2 respect to any interstate services for which there are sepa-
- 3 rately-stated toll charges, be treated as a provider of inter-

4 state, interexchange telecommunications services.".
