2	a rural referral center under subparagraph (C)" and
3	inserting "described in subclause (III)"; and
4	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-

6	"(III) A hospital described in this subclause is a hos-
7	pital that is located in a rural area and has at least 100
8	beds or is classified as a rural referral center under sub-
9	paragraph (C).".
