A BILL

To clarify that buildings administered by the Architect of the Capitol are covered by certain Federal building energy management requirements and energy efficiency standards.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ENERGY MANAGEMENT REQUIREMENTS.**

4 Section 551 of the National Energy Conservation
5 Policy Act (42 U.S.C. 8259) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1), by inserting “, and in-
2 cludes the Architect of the Capitol” after “United
3 States Code”; and

4 (2) in paragraph (9), by inserting “, except
5 that, with respect to buildings under the jurisdiction
6 of the Architect of the Capitol, such term means the
7 committees of the House of Representatives and the
8 Senate with jurisdiction over the Architect of the
9 Capitol” after “Secretary of Energy”.

10 **SEC. 2. ENERGY EFFICIENCY STANDARDS.**

11 Section 303 of the Energy Conservation and Produc-
12 tion Act (42 U.S.C. 6832) is amended—

13 (1) in paragraph (5), by inserting “, and in-
14 cludes the Architect of the Capitol” after “Mortgage
15 Corporation”; and

16 (2) in paragraph (10), by inserting “, except
17 that, with respect to buildings under the jurisdiction
18 of the Architect of the Capitol, such term means the
19 committees of the House of Representatives and the
20 Senate with jurisdiction over the Architect of the
21 Capitol” after “Urban Development”.
