**3 SECTION 1. USE OF RESERVE MONTGOMERY GI BILL EDU-**

4 CATION BENEFITS FOR PAYMENT FOR LI-5 CENSING OR CERTIFICATION TESTS.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 16131 of title 10, United
7 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol8 lowing new subsection:

"(j)(1) Subject to paragraph (3), the amount of edu cational assistance payable under this chapter for a licens ing or certification test described in section 3452(b) of
 title 38, is the lesser of \$2,000 or the fee charged for the
 test.

6 "(2) The number of months of entitlement charged 7 in the case of any individual for such licensing or certifi-8 cation test is equal to the number (including any fraction) 9 determined by dividing the total amount of educational as-10 sistance paid such individual for such test by the full-time monthly institutional rate of educational assistance which, 11 12 but for paragraph (1), such individual would otherwise be 13 paid under subsection (b).

"(3) In no event shall payment of educational assistance under this subsection for such a test exceed the
amount of the individual's available entitlement under this
chapter.".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
subsection (a) shall take effect on October 1, 2005, and
shall apply to tests administered on or after that date.
