## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to prevent the selling of telephone customer proprietary network information.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Secure Telephone Op-  
5       erations Act of 2006”.

6       **SEC. 2. SALE OF TELEPHONE CUSTOMER PROPRIETARY**  
7       **NETWORK INFORMATION.**

8       (a) PROHIBITION.—Chapter 88 of title 18, United  
9       States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
10      lowing:

1 **“§ 1802. Sale of telephone customer proprietary net-**  
2 **work information**

3 “(a) Whoever knowingly sells telephone customer pro-  
4 prietary network information shall be fined under this title  
5 or imprisoned not more than 10 years, or both.

6 “(b) In this section, the term ‘telephone customer  
7 proprietary network information’ means customer propri-  
8 etary network information as that term is defined in sec-  
9 tion 222 of the Communications Act of 1934.”.

10 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT TO TABLE OF SEC-  
11 TIONS.—The table of sections at the beginning of chapter  
12 88 of title 18, United States Code, is amended by adding  
13 at the end the following new item:

“1802. Sale of telephone customer proprietary network information”.
