To amend title 18, United States Code, to prevent the selling of telephone customer proprietary network information.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Secure Telephone Op-
- 5 erations Act of 2006".
- 6 SEC. 2. SALE OF TELEPHONE CUSTOMER PROPRIETARY
- 7 **NETWORK INFORMATION.**
- 8 (a) Prohibition.—Chapter 88 of title 18, United
- 9 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 10 lowing:

1 "§ 1802. Sale of telephone customer proprietary net-

- 2 work information
- 3 "(a) Whoever knowingly sells telephone customer pro-
- 4 prietary network information shall be fined under this title
- 5 or imprisoned not more than 10 years, or both.
- 6 "(b) In this section, the term 'telephone customer
- 7 proprietary network information' means customer propri-
- 8 etary network information as that term is defined in sec-
- 9 tion 222 of the Communications Act of 1934.".
- 10 (b) Clerical Amendment to Table of Sec-
- 11 TIONS.—The table of sections at the beginning of chapter
- 12 88 of title 18, United States Code, is amended by adding
- 13 at the end the following new item:

"1802. Sale of telephone customer proprietary network information".
