1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATIONAL PARK SERVICE STUDY REGARDING**
4 **THE 9–11 MEMORIAL IN WEST ORANGE, NEW**
5 **JERSEY.**

6 (a) STUDY.—The Secretary of the Interior, in con-
7 sultation with the State of New Jersey, shall carry out

1 a study regarding the suitability and feasibility of design-
2 nating the the 9–11 Memorial in West Orange, New Jer-
3 sey, as a unit of the National Park System.

4 (b) STUDY PROCESS AND COMPLETION.—Except as
5 provided by subsection (e) of this section, section 8(c) of
6 Public Law 91–383 (16 U.S.C. 1a–5(c)) shall apply to the
7 conduct and completion of the study required by this sec-
8 tion.

9 (c) SUBMISSION OF STUDY RESULTS.—Not later
10 than 3 years after the date that funds are made available
11 for this section, the Secretary shall submit to the Com-
12 mittee on Resources of the House of Representatives and
13 the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of the
14 Senate a report describing the results of the study.
