- 5 JERSEY.
- 6 (a) STUDY.—The Secretary of the Interior, in con-
- 7 sultation with the State of New Jersey, shall carry out

- 1 a study regarding the suitability and feasibility of desig-
- 2 nating the the 9–11 Memorial in West Orange, New Jer-
- 3 sey, as a unit of the National Park System.
- 4 (b) Study Process and Completion.—Except as
- 5 provided by subsection (e) of this section, section 8(c) of
- 6 Public Law 91–383 (16 U.S.C. 1a–5(c)) shall apply to the
- 7 conduct and completion of the study required by this sec-
- 8 tion.
- 9 (c) Submission of Study Results.—Not later
- 10 than 3 years after the date that funds are made available
- 11 for this section, the Secretary shall submit to the Com-
- 12 mittee on Resources of the House of Representatives and
- 13 the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of the
- 14 Senate a report describing the results of the study.
